Dear Jaymeson Wickins,

The consent resolution agreement between you, the Commissioner of the Alberta Teaching Profession Commission, and Alberta Education's Registrar has been referred to me pursuant to section 225.994(2) of the *Education Act*, as it contains a recommendation to suspend your Permanent Professional Certificate (number [REDACTED]) for a period of three months.

Upon careful review and consideration of the consent resolution agreement, I concur with all parties that your actions were detrimental to the best interests of students, the public, teachers or teacher leaders, or the teaching profession, constituting unprofessional conduct according to section 225.4(b) of the *Education Act*. Therefore, I accept the recommendation of all parties to the consent resolution agreement and suspend your Permanent Professional Certificate for a period of three months from May 16, 2025, to August 8, 2025, inclusive, per section 225.994(3)(c) of the *Education Act*.

The relevant legislation provisions are enclosed for your reference. A copy of this letter will be placed on your Alberta Teacher Registry file, and the consent resolution agreement and my decision will be published to the online Teacher and Teacher Leader Registry per section 225.99991(3) of the *Education Act*.
