Dear Mr. Hogan:

I have received the June 6, 2011 decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Professional Conduct Committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association. The hearing committee has found you guilty of unprofessional conduct for engaging in unacceptable physical contact with a student in a manner that failed to treat the student with dignity and respect and recommends that your teaching certificate be suspended for a period of six months.

I have reviewed the committee's decision and hereby suspend your Alberta Permanent Professional Certificate for a period of six months from the date of this letter.

Upon the expiry of the six-month suspension period, you may apply for reinstatement of your teaching certificate by sending your written request to the Registrar, Alberta Education, 2nd Floor, 44 Capital Boulevard, 10044 - 108 Street, Edmonton, Alberta T5J 5E6. Please note that until you receive official written notification from the Registrar that your certificate has been reinstated, the certificate remains under suspension and invalid.
