Dear Mr. Breakey:

The decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Professional Conduct Committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association has been referred to me, pursuant to the *Teaching Profession Act*. A copy of the decision has been enclosed for your reference.

As you are aware, the hearing committee found you guilty of unprofessional conduct for making highly inappropriate comments to students and forcibly restraining a student. The hearing committee recommended that I suspend your teaching certificate for three months.

I have reviewed the matter and, based upon the Reasons for Decision and Reasons for Penalty set out in the committee's decision, I do not support the committee's recommendation that your teaching certificate be suspended for three months. Instead, I am of the view that the circumstances presented in the committee's decision warrants cancellation of your Permanent Professional Certificate.

I hereby cancel your Alberta Permanent Professional Certificate # effective immediately, pursuant to Sections 31 and 32 of the *Certification of Teachers and Teacher Leaders Regulation*. A copy of the regulation is enclosed for your reference.
