Dear Ms. Tungal:


The decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Professional Conduct Committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association has been referred to me, pursuant to the *Teaching Profession Act*. A copy of the decision is enclosed for your reference.

As you are aware, the hearing committee found your conduct to be unprofessional when you engaged in actions that were detrimental to the best interests of students and the public, when you did, for a sexual purpose, unlawfully touch, directly or indirectly, with a part of the body or with an object, the body of a student, a person under the age of years, contrary to Section 151 of the *Criminal Code* (Canada), for which you were convicted of an indictable offence.

The hearing committee recommended that I cancel your teaching certificate. I have reviewed the matter and, based on the hearing committee's decision, reasons for the decision and penalty set out in the decision, I am of the view that the seriousness of your unprofessional conduct warrants the cancellation of your Permanent Professional Certificate.

I hereby cancel your Alberta Permanent Professional Certificate effective immediately, pursuant to Sections 31 and 32 of the Certification of Teachers and Teacher Leaders Regulation.
