Dear Ms. Chilton:

The September 30, 2013 decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association's Professional Conduct Committee and March 28, 2014 decision of the Alberta Teachers' Association's Professional Conduct Appeal Committee has been referred to me, pursuant to the Certification of Teachers Regulation. As you are aware, the committees found your conduct unprofessional, and the appeal committee recommended I suspend your teaching certificate for a six-year period.

I have reviewed the matter, and based upon the Reasons for Decision and Reasons for Penalty set out in the hearing committee's decision, and Reasons for Decision set out in the appeal committee's decision, I have decided not to follow the appeal committee's recommendation. Instead, I find the seriousness of the charges presented in the hearing committee's decision warrants cancellation of your Permanent Professional Certificate.

Therefore, instead of suspending your teaching certificate, I hereby cancel your Alberta Permanent Professional Certificate, effective immediately, pursuant to sections 25 and 26 of the Certification of Teachers Regulation. A copy of the regulation is attached for your reference.
