Dear Ms. Lang:

The decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Professional Conduct Committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association has been referred to me, pursuant to the *Teaching Profession Act*. A copy of the decision is enclosed for your reference.

As you are aware, the hearing committee found you guilty of unprofessional conduct. Your conduct subsequently resulted in a criminal conviction, for which you were incarcerated, required to complete court-mandated counselling and register as a sexual offender for a term of 10 years.

I have reviewed the matter, the Reasons for Decision and the Reasons for Penalty set out in the committee's decision. The hearing committee recommended that you be permanently ineligible for a teaching certificate, as you currently do not hold valid teaching authority in Alberta, given that your Interim Professional Certificate [REDACTED] expired on [REDACTED].

Given the serious nature of your unprofessional conduct, I have directed the Registrar's Office to put the hearing committee's decision on your teacher file in the Teacher Registry to ensure that this information will inform the Registrar in making a decision to deny you future certification in Alberta, should you attempt to request a re-issuance of your expired Alberta teaching certificate in the future.

A copy of the Certification of Teachers and Teacher Leaders Regulation is also enclosed for your reference.
