Dear Ms. Ryder:

The decision and recommendation of the hearing committee of the Professional Conduct Committee of the Alberta Teachers' Association has been referred to me, pursuant to the *Teaching Profession Act*. A copy of the decision is enclosed for your reference.

As you are aware, the hearing committee found your conduct to be unprofessional when you engaged in actions that were detrimental to the best interests of the public and students by allowing the use of your debit card – assigned to you in your role as co-chair of the [REDACTED] School Advisory Council and the Parent Advisory Council – to withdraw more than \$30,000 from automated teller machines for non-school advisory council or parent advisory council purposes.

The hearing committee recommended that I cancel your teaching certificate. I have reviewed the matter and, based on the hearing committee's decision, reasons for the decision and penalty set out in the decision, I am of the view that the seriousness of your unprofessional conduct warrants cancellation of your Permanent Professional Certificate.

I hereby cancel your Alberta Permanent Professional Certificate [REDACTED] effective immediately, pursuant to Sections 31 and 32 of the Certification of Teachers and Teacher Leaders Regulation.
